CSPRS Green Asia Award

The Green Asia Award is sponsored by the Chinese (Taipei) Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (CSPRS) to promote researches directing to a greener Asia with remote sensing and spatial information technologies. The prize of the award will be USD \$300 (or equivalent gifts) with a certificate. Two winners will be awarded every year. At least one will be selected from papers published in the Asian Journal of Geoinformatics (AJG); and the other is open to all authors submitting papers to the Asian Conference on Remote Sensing. The application and evaluation procedure of the Green Asia Award is described as listed below.

Qualifications:

- 1. There is no age limitation for applicants.
- 2. The applicant must be the first or corresponding author of a full paper submitted to ACRS.
- 3. The applicant must present the paper in an oral or interactive (poster) session of ACRS in person.

Procedure and Requirements:

- In addition to submitting a full paper to ACRS, the applicant must also send the full paper with a cover letter and a Curriculum Vitae (CV) to the office of the Chinese (Taipei) Society of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing by email <mail to: csprsmail@csprs.org.tw by the deadline of ACRS full paper submission.
- 2. **IMPORTANT**: The awarded paper(s) will be transferred to AJG editorial office for peer-review and publication, if accepted. The applicants must undertake subsequent revision process. *The full paper(s) should NOT be included in ACRS proceedings.*
- 3. A panel appointed by CSPRS will evaluate the papers and presentations.
- 4. The winners will be notified by email and announced at the opening or closing ceremony of ACRS.
